

JOHAN GALTUNG: BOOKS PUBLISHED 1953 - 2007

This list contains a total of 244 monographs in four categories:

1. Books. Some translations and new editions are listed as separate books here, because they often include new forewords or revisions (129 entries). 34 books were translated into 29 languages, for a total of 124 book translations.
2. Edited Books (21 entries)
3. Books/Papers published from Institutions (22 entries)
4. Books/Papers written from the Chair in Conflict and Peace Research, University of Oslo, 1969-1977 (66 entries)

The 4-digit numbers in parentheses refer to the publication number in the bibliography on the TRANSCEND website (www.transcend.org, 1696 entries by 27 September 2007). The first two digits indicate the year, and the last two the publication number within that year (for example, book 5305 is the 5th publication in 1953).
